***Medical and Behavioral Issues in Down Syndrome***



George T. Capone, M.D., the director of the Down Syndrome Program at the Kennedy-Krieger Institute, Baltimore, will be the keynote speaker at an upcoming conference sponsored by the Kennedy♦Willis Center on Down Syndrome at Pathfinder Village, Edmeston, New York. Dr. Capone is a research scientist at KKI, and is also an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine.

Dr. Capone attended Wesleyan University and worked as a research assistant at the Dana Farber Cancer Institute, Boston, before obtaining his M.D. from the University of Connecticut in 1983. After a residency and fellowship in pediatrics at the Childrens' Hospital Medical Center, Cincinnati, Dr. Capone came to Baltimore in 1988 to pursue a fellowship in neurobiology research at Johns Hopkins. Dr. Capone currently serves as the director of KKI's Down Syndrome Clinic, and is an Attending Physician on KKI's Comprehensive Rehabilitation Unit.

Dr. Capone and his colleagues are committed to research that explores the neurobiologic basis of cognitive impairment and co-morbid neurobehavioral and psychiatric disorders associated with Down syndrome. Dr. Capone has been published in such respected journals as the *Journal of Developmental & Behavioral Pediatrics*, *Journal of the Neurological Sciences*, and the *American Journal of Medical Genetics*.
